Welcome to the 2017 NICL Conference Cross Country meet to be held on Saturday, October 14 at the Oakleaf Country Club in Reinbeck. The golf course is located approximately two miles west of Reinbeck on Highway 175.

The schedule is as follows:

9:30 am Jr. High Girls (top 10 medal)
9:50 am Jr. High Boys (top 10 medal)
10:10 am Varsity Girls --- run 7, score 5
10:35 am Varsity Boys --- run 7, score 5
11:00 am JV Girls - (top 10 medal)
11:30 am JV Boys - (top 10 medal)

Awards upon conclusion of JV Boys race will be held on the porch of the clubhouse.

If possible, we will try to run ahead of schedule but we will not start another race before the preceding race is finished. The course this year will be the same as last year.

Junior High and JV awards will be handed out in the chute. Varsity will be given after all races at the ceremony on the porch of the clubhouse. Top twenty (20) varsity boys will receive medals and 1st and 2nd team all conference honors. Top twenty (20) varsity girls will receive medals and 1st and 2nd team all conference honors. Runners twenty-one (21) through thirty (30) will be honorable mention for both boys and girls.

The Junior Varsity races will be run as a JV Invitational. The top 10 girls and top 10 boys will receive medals in the chute.

Coaches, please pick up your packets at the van by the finish line when you arrive.

The meet will be scored this year by Hilltopper Results. Coaches, you **MUST** submit all names and entries by the dates and methods explained in the letter. Deadline: Sunday, October 8th @11:00p.m
