Warm-up will be prior to your first competition and will be 5-6-6.  
Games will be played within five minutes of completion of the prior match with a 4-1 warm-up.  
The upper gym will be available to share throughout the day.

You must provide your own warm-up balls. Locker rooms will be available and assigned on site; bring locks since you will be sharing locker rooms with other teams. West High is not responsible for stolen or misplaced items.

Coin flip before each game will determine the home team. Another coin flip will determine the serve or receive.

Top two teams in each pool will move to the championship round.

Awards: The first place team will receive a Championship plaque and 15 championship medals.

Second place team will receive a plaque and 15 runner up medals.

Concessions: Will be available throughout the day. No outside food will be allowed.  
Scorekeepers and line judges will be provided.

### Method of Play

Play will consist of each team playing 2 out of 3 games to 21 points (NO CAP), third game to 15 points (NO CAP), in your pool. Tie breaking procedure is as follows:

Two-way tie in a pool

- 1) Head-to-head competition

Three-way tie in a pool

- 1) We will play a one-set to 15 points (NO CAP), seeded playoff to determine the top two teams.
- 2) The team with the best point-spread differential will receive the bye. The other two teams will compete in one play-in set to 15 points. (NO CAP)
- 3) The winner of the play-in set will play the top seed to determine Pool Champion and Pool Runner-up, for bracketing purposes.

The top two teams in each pool will advance to the Championship bracket. The championship bracket will consist of each team playing 2 out of 3 games to 25 points (NO CAP), third game to 15 points (NO CAP).
